to as **SECOND PARTIES**.

Based on the foregoing, the **PARTIES** agreed to enter into a Cooperation
Agreement in the Field of Higher Education Tri Dharma, with the following
provisions:

ARTICLE 1

SCOPE

The scope of this Cooperation Agreement includes:

1. Education and Teaching;
2. Study;
3. Community service;
4. Human Resources Management;
5. Other activities agreed by the PARTIES.

ARTICLE 2

PERIOD OF ACT

1. This Cooperation Agreement is valid for a period of 5 (Five) Years as of the date signed by the **PARTIES** ;
2. This Cooperation Agreement may be extended according to the agreement of the **PARTIES** no later than 3 months before the expiration of this Cooperation Agreement.

This Cooperation Agreement may be terminated prior to the period as referred to in paragraph (1) provided that the **PARTIES** intending to terminate the Memorandum of Understanding shall notify the other **PARTIES in writing of the intention** no later than 1 week prior to the termination of this Cooperation Agreement.

ARTICLE 3

FINANCING

The costs incurred as a result of the implementation of this Cooperation Agreement shall be borne and agreed upon by the **PARTIES** and in accordance with the laws and regulations and shall be further regulated in the Cooperation Agreement.

ARTICLE 4

OTHER PROVISIONS

1. Matters deemed necessary and not yet regulated in this Cooperation Agreement will be regulated and determined by the **PARTIES** in the addendum to the Cooperation Agreement which will become an integral part of this Cooperation Agreement;
2. If there are differences of interpretation in the implementation of this Cooperation Agreement, the **PARTIES shall coordinate their settlement by** means of deliberation to reach consensus.

ARTICLE 5

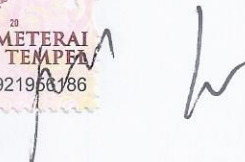
